

This custom saddle has been cleaned and conditioned more than it has been ridden (4x). It is dark brown, has a 16.5 seat size for med. build or tall, slender male or female rider approx. 5¹3²-5¹8² in height and between 125-165lbs. My inseam is 29² but saddle has ample room for adjustment to leglength. Saddle tooled with Parelli Horseheads Pattern, Savvy Club memberprice is \$3096 for saddle alone. Comes with buck rolls, breast collar (\$89), Theraflex Nat. Performer Saddle Pad (\$330), and Mohair Cinch (\$44), all Parelli products. Valued at \$3559. Available NOW. This saddle was one of the first of the new line as an update from the FUSION. I'm selling it because I have a Parelli Fusion Saddle that fits me better, and I've switched to dressage riding which requires a different

saddle. This saddle is gorgeous and works beautifully with the Theraflex Pad (properly shimmed) for your horse's comfort. I've cared for it like a baby. Conditioned several times according to the saddle maker's suggestions and kept covered inside my house. There are a couple scratch marks, visible in the photos, but you have to look hard to see them. This saddle is in great condition and it should fit any average sized horse (with the exception of some draft breeds) withuse of the Theraflex saddle pad system.
